




Single Section Softback page I

This is a useful bind to master since it can be adapted many ways by adding sections or a hard cover, this is the most basic form.











1. cut out a stack of pages for the book, For this example cut 8 pages: 240mm x 140mm


Fold the pages in half and sit them, one in another














4.Thread a needle with bookbinding thread, pull so both ends are level - but don't knot.
You need more than you think, for this example try 80cm of thread, once doubled it will be 40cm long






Once sewn, open the book flat with the inside facing you and tie a reef-knot to finish. 5. Sew the book together, following these diagrams.

6. Reef-Knot

Tie the knot across the central thread to lock in place then trim - not too close to the knot



Close the book and press the folds again to finish the book. If you have lots of pages inside the book, they may need cutting square with a guillotine or a sharp knife & metal ruler. It is easier to do this when they've all been sewn together rather than when they're all loose
